:: Purposes...

- ◆ For each preteen to develop leadership skills, a servant's heart, and his or her relationship with Christ.
- ◆ For each preteen to begin exploring ministry opportunities and develop his or her gifts and talents.
- ◆ For each preteen to become an active part of the Body of Christ and to understand the importance of his or her active participation in the Church.

:: Responsibilities and Expectations...

- ◆ Must attend 70% of Port56 services, including Sunday and Wednesday.
- ◆ Call at least a week in advance before a service in which they are unable to attend – except in cases of emergencies.
- ◆ Set an example during services by participating in worship, inviting and welcoming new kids, contributing to small group discussions, and having positive attitudes.
